# What is DECODE?

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DECODE is an Erasmus+ Youth Exchange designed to offer young people aged 18 to 25 from six partner countries an opportunity for non-formal and informal learning, with a focus on digital literacy, critical thinking, and resilience to online manipulation.

# bjectives



To counter youth radicalization through intercultural and interreligious dialogue, understanding the values of the European Union, and the value of European citizenship.



To develop digital literacy and fact-checking skills to recognize the psycho-emotional harm of radical content and combat the threat to European values, analyzing ICT both for their educational and innovative value, as well as their role as vehicles for psychological manipulation, recruitment of vulnerable youth, and deep fakes.



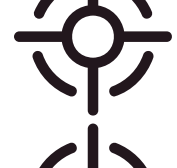
To develop prevention strategies to recognize and counter the risk factors of online youth radicalization, violent extremism, and the normalization of violence.



To share best practices in digital safety and personal data protection.



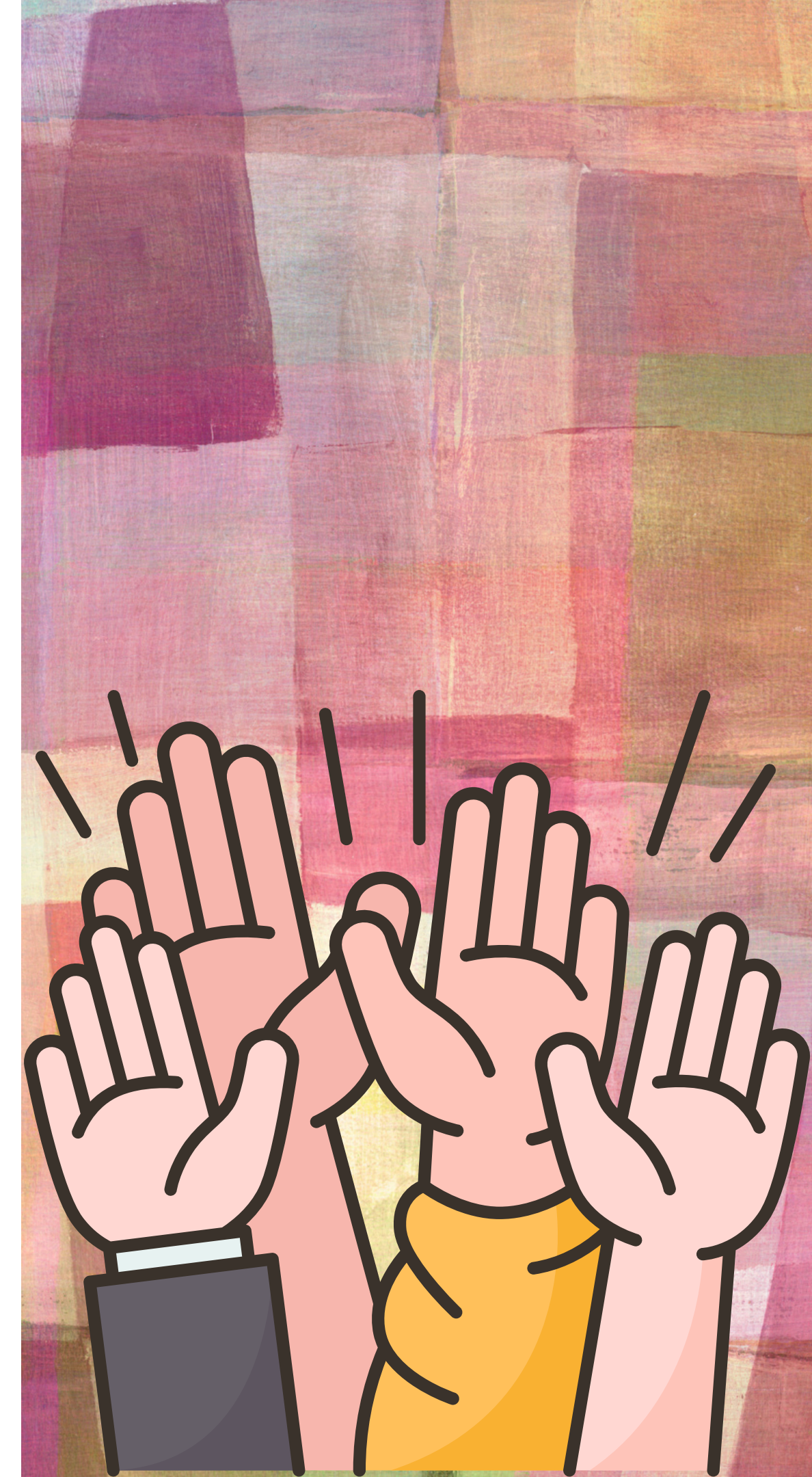
To promote civic sense and participation in the European Union and its values.



To facilitate access to European opportunities for young people with fewer opportunities.



To develop two tangible outputs: a digital documentary project on European belonging and a Decalogue of best practices for fact-checking and debunking extremist ideologies and deep fakes.



# How, and who?

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DECODE will be based on a wide **mix of non-formal education methods**. Activities will be in English. The **facilitation team** will be made by Evelyn De Luca and Pietro Tasso (Italy), youth workers, trainers and graphic facilitators from Oriel APS.

## Selection of pax and responsibilities

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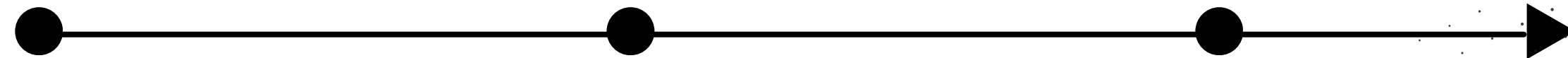
All organizations are **responsible** for the preparation, support, monitoring of participants together with the hosting team. **Each partner will take care of the selection process giving priority to youth that never took part in Erasmus+ mobilities, AGED 18-25 AND NO AGE LIMIT FOR THE GROUP LEADER**, and the suggested participants will be shared with Oriel APS, that will read the applications and **DOUBLE-CONFIRM** each one. Until the double-confirmation from Oriel APS, participants are not officially selected.

The partners undertake to sign and comply the mandate, which governs the **legal obligations** and **rights** of partner organizations. Each partner will participate in and support the **follow-up activities** and the **dissemination strategy**.





# Who are we?



**Oriel Association** was founded in 2017 and its main office is in the province of **Verona**, Italy, but it's active all over Italy.

The **mission** of the association is to promote the active participation of young people in their local communities and to give them the chance and the tools to exploit fully their potential and to provide them a support in discovering their path and to develop their skills by using non-formal education and intercultural learning methods.

To pursue these goals we organize cultural events, seminars, workshops and study lessons. We provide several training courses in the local community and we work with different **European grants**, like Erasmus+.

The maximum **TRAVEL COST** reimbursement is based on the distance calculator supported by the European Union.

When participants will arrive in Sant'Anna, we will provide transportation with our van to take them to the accommodation. The same service will be offered for the return trip. These travel costs have already been deducted. We will NOT reimburse the amounts that get **over the maximum budget** for each participant, or the tickets that did not receive **previous APPROVAL** from the Italian NGO Oriel APS.

# Costs

For the **TRAVEL**, according to the restrictions of the E+ Programme, **we can only refund if:**

Your travel route is **from your hometown to the venue** in Italy and back

(check for exceptional cases with the coordinator);

You have chosen **reasonable and economical means** of transportation (e.g. APEX or student fares for flight tickets, cheap airlines, 2nd class trains);

your travel dates must comply with the project guidelines.

You are allowed to arrive up to 2 days before the official start date or depart up to 2 days after the end date.

For example, you may: arrive up to 2 days before and/or depart up to 2 days after; arrive 1 day before and depart 1 day after; or choose to use only 1 extra day before or after the project.

Travel on extra days is permitted only if the proposed tickets are less expensive than those available for the official project travel dates.

Please note that accommodation and other expenses during these additional days are at your own cost.

Travel tickets that do not respect these rules will not be reimbursed unless prior approval has been obtained from the project coordinator.

ONLY basic ticket fare is approved (e.g. bag pack & 10 kg trolley).

Additional services (e.g. insurances, additional luggages etc.) cannot be reimbursed.

You need a **receipt or invoice** for the cost of your plane ticket and the **boarding passes** or the train/bus tickets. Again: boarding passes (**DON'T LOSE THEM**)

Tickets (there must be price and name of the person stated on it).

# Costs

**BOARD, LODGING, and PROGRAMME** costs will be provided and paid 100% by grant from the Italian Erasmus+ National Agency.

3 meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and 2 coffee breaks will be provided.





# How to arrive to Verona



There are several options to arrive in Verona.

Most cheap arrival flight points are in the airports of **Milano Malpensa, Milano Bergamo, Venezia Marco Polo, Venezia Treviso and Bologna**. (Very rarely **Verona** itself).

*The project coordinator will support you with the local transportation - please ask him!*

Participants must ensure that their arrival and departure times in Verona align with the schedule of their other means of transportation.

**NOTE! Before booking please confirm the tickets with the project coordinator Sillian (by email, contact details below)!**

**We'll then check the available domestic connections in Italy.**



# Accomodation

During the project we will stay in the countryside of North-Italy in **Sant'Anna D'Alfaedo, close to Verona in CASA SAN GIOVANNI IN LOFFA.**

We will be accommodated in the in rooms of **3-4 people** (divided by gender).

Three meals per day (breakfast, lunch, dinner) plus two coffee breaks will be provided.

Please note that meals will be mainly vegetarian, as part of our commitment to sustainability and reducing environmental impact.

Bed sheets are provided.

Towels are **NOT** provided, please bring your own.
