
TASKS AND OBLIGATIONS FOR PARTNERS ORGANISATIONS

- Each partner will participate in and support the follow-up activities and will contribute to establish strategies for the dissemination and use of the project's results together with their participants.

Objectives



- to familiarize participants with the basics of first aid in different situations
- the use of new life-saving skills through hands-on exercises and simulations
- building good relations between people from different countries
- inclusive atmosphere
- We will organize a first aid training for people from Poland, Italy, Turkey, Spain, Lithuania, Greece, Belgium, and Romania. We invite at least 4 people from each country, 18-30 years old, in total 45 people, whose passion or job is related to the topic of our training or who think may benefit from first aid training. Moreover, together we would also like to organize international and intercultural events for local kids/youth, like first aid games and tournaments for local inhabitants.

Automatic display of feedback:

Feedback on the quality, depth, speed and frequency of compressions and ventilation is displayed in the app.

Gamification! - smart scoring and guidance

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Certified VR training for humans

A version of the certified training using **VR virtual reality technology** and phantoms with sensors and a measuring application.

The training is focused on practical exercises. It includes a theoretical part with discussion session and practical exercises in small groups.

Framework scope and content provided during the training, includes, overall:

- own safety, checking the condition of the victim, ABC (acronym for the most important first aid activities), SAMPLE interview, correct call for help (in virtual reality VR)
- cardiopulmonary resuscitation with the use of AED BLS in children and adults (in virtual reality VR)
- lateral position fixed (in virtual reality VR)
- head and limb injuries (in virtual reality VR)
- haemorrhage and bleeding (in virtual reality VR)
- choking
- severe allergic reaction. stroke
- diabetes
- seizure
- pain in the chest
- shortness of breath, asthma
- legal aspects of first aid, psychological first aid
- CPR for animals:
- summary of the course, distribution of certificates

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Certified VR training

Outdoor and wilderness related topics like e.g.:

- first aid improvised in the field, forms of transport of the injured
- viper bite
- treatment of ticks
- anaphylactic shock
- sunstroke, dehydration

This project will be perfect for people who like outdoors - we are going to have several tours in the outdoor area and field first aid simulations. It's dedicated to youth workers and people whose job, studies or passion is related to the topic of first aid, first aid education, rescue and paramedics.

This training course is for people who are:

- youth workers
- who work in the fields of first aid, rescue, emergency, hospital, medicine, nursery
- guides, tour leaders

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Pre-Veterinary First Aid for Dogs and Cats



Workshop - Pre-Veterinary First Aid for Dogs and Cats (5-hour)

Scope and content covered during the workshop:

- Where to seek help if something happens to your pet? What are the options available at veterinary clinics?
- How to recognize pain and an emergency in an animal and how to assess whether veterinary intervention is necessary?
- How to remain calm and composed in emergency situations, how to ensure your own safety?
- What should a cat or dog owner have in their first aid kit?
- What to do in the event of a road accident involving animals?
- How to provide first aid in the event of respiratory distress? How to respond in the event
 of choking? How to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation in animals? (practical
 exercises using a dog and cat model)
- How to provide first aid in the event of heatstroke, shock, drowning, acute abdomen, or poisoning?
- How to properly treat injuries to the paws, limbs, trunk, and spine (practical exercises in wound care)
- Safe techniques for moving and carrying injured or sick animals, with an emphasis on minimizing additional injuries? (practical exercises)
- How to provide neonatal and perinatal care?

How to get there: You have to take bus from Poznań to Pniewy and we will pick you up from Pniewy to the venue.

Important! Outdoor project and nature-based activities

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By joining this project, you acknowledge that participation will involve **outdoor activities** and the use of **nature-based and ecopsychological methodologies**. During the mobility we will hike together the surrounding outdoor areas, we will have have first aid workshops in the forests area and we will spend most time in the outdoor. Trainers are experienced in first aid.

You are expected to fully and consciously understand the nature of these activities and any potential physical or psychological risks involved. You must ensure that you are in suitable physical and mental condition to actively engage in all planned activities. If you have any physical or mental health conditions that could affect your ability to participate, you are responsible for informing the appropriate medical or psychological professionals about your presence at this training and your intention to take part in the programme. Your participation should be endorsed by those professionals, if relevant. Moreover you have to inform Foundation for the Development of Education and Tourism Rysy about any health issues or other physical issues which may affect your participation in outdoor activities.

By choosing to take part, you do so **voluntarily and of your own free will**, and you **accept full personal responsibility** for your own physical and mental health and safety. You therefore **agree not to hold the Foundation for the Development of Education and Tourism Rysy liable** for any outcomes resulting from your participation in these activities.







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TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT



- The maximum travel cost reimbursement both ways, there and back is based on the distance calculator supported by the European Union. We will NOT reimburse the amounts that get over the maximum budget for each participant.
- Your travel route is from your country to the venue and back (check for exceptional cases with the coordinator). You have chosen reasonable and economic means of transportation (e.g. APEX or student fares for flight tickets, cheap airlines).
- You have a receipt or invoice for the cost of your plane ticket and the boarding cards or the train/bus tickets.
- If you would like to stay longer, you can book flights up to 1 day before/after arrival/departure of the dates of the training. Tickets with dates longer than 1 day after/before the dates of the training will NOT be reimbursed, if not agreed previously with the coordinator.

Travel reimbursements will be provided after sending evidence of implementing dissemination tasks (usually a maximum of 90 days after the end of the training). Dissemination tasks will be sent by email and explained during the mobility. Moreover, all participants are obliged to upload and send to the organizer the reimbursement form and all travel documents, tickets, boarding passes, invoices, and payment confirmations from bank account within 2 weeks after the end of the mobility.

For reimbursement we need:

- 1. <u>our dissemination tasks different group tasks you will be able to complete during the training (like creating short educational videos/materials about the topic of the training)</u>
- all your tickets and boarding passes;
- 3. invoices or receipts from your travel agency or transport company
- 4 confirmation of payment from your bank account this is needed based on polish policy
- 5. dissemination tasks

It's preferable to **upload .pdf documents** rather than printscreens. Please check in the online system or in the mobile flight application if you can download the .pdf or if you have received mail with the details and prices of your flight. You can **download confirmation or print such emails to .pdf** and upload them to the file with your name. According to Polish financial policy we also need all **payment confirmation from your bank accounts.** Please download in .pdf and upload too. **No printscreens!**

Keep in mind that we cannot reimburse taxis or coming by car expenses, travel or medical insurance.

- VR virtual reality, QCPR phantoms with sensors to measure
parameters during cardiopulmonary resuscitation - chest
compression depth, hand positioning, compression speed
and AED - training defibrillators.

We conducted over 600 first aid trainings, we also organized over 100 events combined with first aid training and demonstrations, and our information and education campaign in social media reached organic reach of over 1000,000 recipients via FB, IG, TikTok, YT.
